

# EXHIBIT “C”

## ADOPT-A-ROAD SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

### Participants shall:

- Pick up litter on one side of the road at a time. Participants must park vehicles on the same side of the road where they are picking up the litter.
- Avoid entering vehicular travel lanes whenever possible. Do not pick up litter located on vehicular travel lanes. Only cross vehicular travel lanes when it is safe to do so.
- Upon arriving at the work site, immediately display the “Litter Crew Ahead” safety sign in advance of the pickup site (one (1) in each direction).
- Not possess or consume alcoholic beverages.
- Conduct at least one (1) safety orientation meeting during the year.
- Provide appropriate and adequate adult supervision when youth groups are involved in litter pickups. At least one (1) adult per eight (8) participants between the ages of 10 and 17 is required.
- Not conduct litter pickups during peak traffic hours, holidays, holiday travel weekends, the day preceding a holiday, the day following a holiday, the Friday preceding a holiday weekend and the Monday following a holiday weekend (see Agreement for list of holidays when pickup is prohibited).
- Stay clear of all construction areas.
- Conduct pre-pickup safety talks.
- Avoid all horseplay or demonstrations of any nature.
- Wear the safety vest provided by the Township at all times.
- Avoid hazardous materials such as old car batteries or any unidentified questionable items and animal carcasses. For proper disposal, please report the type and location of any hazardous materials to the Township.
- Be aware of all known allergies of volunteers before participation (bee stings, poison ivy, poison oak).
- Be familiar with the following safety recommendations:
  - ❖ Know emergency procedures such as the location of the nearest emergency facility, and how to quickly summon the police or ambulance. It is highly recommended that at least one (1) participant possess a cell phone for use in the event of an emergency. All participants should be informed of the person carrying the cell phone and instructed to alert that person should an emergency occur.

- ❖ Provide a First-Aid Kit and alert participants to the location of the First-Aid Kit.
- ❖ Avoid over exertion and heat problems by drinking water and taking breaks.
- ❖ Carpool to the litter pickup site.
- ❖ Wear the recommended attire: Long sleeves, blue jeans or long pants, leather shoes or boots, and gloves.
- ❖ Be careful of contact with poisonous plants, bees, wasps, hornets, fire-ants, and snakes. The recommended attire will usually prevent irritations from most poisonous plants.
- ❖ Pay special attention to the handling of broken glass. Participants must be careful not to step or kneel on broken glass.
- ❖ Be aware of visibility problems.
- ❖ Be prepared for any unexpected behavior of motorists.
- ❖ Park vehicles a safe distance from the traveled roadway.
- ❖ Attempt to walk facing on-coming traffic.
- ❖ Do not stand or jump on guiderails, drainage pipes or on concrete walls.
